

OUR JOURNEY

DAY 1 | VIP Welcome to Nairobi

You'll be met on arrival, assisted through immigration + customs, and escorted to the landmark *Fairmont Norfolk Hotel*.

DAY 2 | Into the Maasai Mara

Both the Giraffe Center and David Sheldrick Wildlife Trust are hailed for helping to save the Rothschild giraffe, elephant and rhino. But it was the passion to preserve Kenya's wildlife that drove two families to establish these organizations that will inspire you. Dine at *Tamambo Karen Blixen*, set on the author's homestead, before flying into the Maasai Mara where big game roam in the same super-abundance that thrilled Teddy Roosevelt. You'll be welcomed by Maasai dancers and cool eucalyptus-scented towels. At the *Fairmont Mara Safari Club*, unwind on your verandah overlooking the hippo and crocodile-filled Mara River. DAY 3 | Ballooning over the Maasai Mara

The sun's rays are just beginning to flicker across the sky as you float silently above the game-filled expanse of the Maasai Mara, home to large herds of herbivores and their ferocious predators! After lunch, luxuriate in the ambience of the *Fairmont Club* before an exhilarating safari drive and another chance to spot all of the Big Five.

DAY 4 | Onward to Amboseli

Enjoy a morning game drive before your included safari flight to Amboseli National Park. Set against the majestic silhouette of Kilimanjaro, Africa's tallest peak, Amboseli

is heralded for its quintessentially African landscapes of open plains, rolling savanna and acacia woodlands. Spend two nights at the inviting *Ol Tukai Lodge*. MEALS B+L+D

DAY 5 | Game drives in the shadow of Mt. Kilimanjaro

Amboseli National Park is heralded as the best place in Africa to get close to vast herds of free-ranging elephants... DAY 7 | To Ngorongoro Crater

With more than 400 species on record, including magnificent raptors and a rich variety of shore birds, Lake Manyara is a birder's paradise. Elephants, Sykes' monkeys, olive baboons, giraffes, zebras and bushbucks are among the mammals you might also see on this morning's game drive. Midday finds you gazing across the world's largest intact caldera from your luxury tent at *Lemala Ngorongoro*. Later, thoughtful engagement with Maasai villagers reveals the challenges and rewards of life in East Africa.

DAY 8 | First on the crater floor

Encircled by towering peaks, the grasslands of Ngorongoro are easy for officials to patrol, resulting in healthy populations of endangered species like black rhino and cheetah. And with Lemala's privileged access, you'll bypass the line of vehicles at the main entry for truly exciting, unmatched gameviewing on the crater floor — before other visitors have even arrived. Return to camp for lunch and a relaxing afternoon. MEALS B+L+D



OUR JOURNEY

DAY 1 | Welcome to Arusha

You'll be greeted upon arrival at Kilimanjaro Airport and escorted to *The Arusha Hotel*. Tracing its history to 1894, our landmark property is infused with the spirit of classic safaris from a bygone era. Now managed by *Sheraton*, it offers every modern comfort including free WiFi.

DAY 2 | To Lake Manyara

Journey to Lake Manyara, acclaimed by Hemingway as "the loveliest lake in Africa." It's also home to more than 400 bird species and numerous large mammals including elephant, giraffe, hippo, wildebeest, zebra and the fearsome Cape buffalo. Settle in to your luxury villa at *Kilimamoja Lodge* and join our expert safari guide on your first bush walk and game drive. After Sundowner cocktails and an elegant dinner, head out again for a thrilling night safari to track nocturnal animals.

DAY 3 | Onward to Ngorongoro Crater

Big game is just one facet of Africa that will inspire you; this morning's visit to spend time with students and staff at a school is another, providing memorable insight into the challenges and rewards of life in Tanzania. Continue to *Lemala Ngorongoro*; perched on the crater's rim, our luxury safari camp offers your first look at the captivating beauty of the world's largest intact caldera. After lunch, tear yourself away from the view to visit a Maasai village. This evening, a chief's son offers his own personal insight into Maasai culture.

DAY 4 | First on the Crater floor

With its vast expanses of open grassland surrounded by steep cliffs, Ngorongoro Crater (a) is easy for game officials to patrol; the result is abundant wildlife including rare species like black rhino and cheetah. Our camp enjoys a prime location by the Lemala Crater Access Route and you'll descend quickly this morning for a spectacular game drive before other visitors have even arrived on the crater floor.

DAY 5 | The Central Serengeti

At Olduvai Gorge, learn about the passions that drove Louis and Mary Leakey to their startling 1.8 million-year-old fossil discoveries. Continue your journey into the vast expanse of the Central Serengeti ©, unequaled for its beauty and the concentration of its wildlife – including the Big 5 as well as numerous other herbivores and the fierce predators which are rarely far behind. Enjoy a game drive before Sundowner cocktails and an elegant dinner at the exclusive *Lemala Ewanjan*.

DAY 6 | Ballooning over the Serengeti

Animals too have their routines and this morning's hot air balloon safari in the sharp light of dawn allows you to gaze down as they greet another day. Touch down for a champagne breakfast and a morning game drive. Back at camp, you'll have ample time to relax and share your impressions of Africa with your fellow adventurers. A late afternoon safari drive promises more encounters with the primates, birds, horned bovines, wild dogs, and big cats that roam the Serengeti.

DAY 7 | Tracking game across the plains

The Maasai call it Siringitu – The place where the land moves on forever. Indeed, these wide open spaces are as awe-inspiring in their natural beauty as they are rich in wildlife. Join our expert safari guide for another day of heart-pounding morning and afternoon game drives. As dusk descends, enjoy Sundowner cocktails and a candle-lit dinner under the darkening sky. DAY 1 | Our VIP Arrival Services in Nairobi

On arrival, you'll be met and assisted through immigration and custom formalities. Then we take you to Hemingways Nairobi Hotel.

DAY 2 | Into the Fabled Maasai Mara

This morning's safari transfer flight promises cinematic aerial views high above the African landscapes! Touching down by the Maasai Mara National Reserve, you'll be warmly greeted and escorted to Kichwa Tembo Camp, set on a private concession bordering the Reserve. An afternoon game drive begins your exploration of the Mara – widely acclaimed as Kenya's finest wildlife destination. MEALS B+L+D

DAY 3 | Balloon Safari + Game Drives

Floating silently above in a Hot Air Balloon, you'll have an incredible bird's-eye view of the Maasai Mara – and the animals as they begin their day just as they have for millennia. Touch down in the open savanna and delight in an al fresco Champagne Breakfast. With its vast undisturbed panoramas of rolling plains, punctuated by the iconic silhouette of acacia trees, the Maasai Mara is ravishing in its wild beauty and celebrated as one of the richest wildlife habitats on the Planet. The Serengeti is famed for its concentration of plains game including the Big Five, so your morning and afternoon safari drives promise plenty of wildlife excitement. During the Great Migration River Crossings, our luxury lodge is perfectly positioned for the unfolding drama as thousands of wildebeest and zebra mass along the Mara River in preparation to ford its CUrrents. MEALS B+L+D

DAY 7 | Another Thrilling Day on Safari
