



DAY 2 | The best of Kyoto

Your tour of Kyoto (includes Nijo Castle, Kinkakuji Temple and Sanjusangendo with its 1,001 statues of Kannon, Goddess of Mercy. Delve into Japan's traditions when you dine with Geisha and stroll in Gion where Kabuki traditions began long ago.

DAY 3 | Miyajima + Hiroshima



Your touring begins at the resplendent Gyeongbokgung Palace where you'll see the Royal Changing of the Guard, a colorful spectacle that traces its roots to 1469! On the grounds of the Palace, the National Folk Museum offers insight into history and culture. Stroll through bustling Insadong,

home to antique shops and galleries, and then explore the country's first daily market – still a foodie's paradise!

From the Dora Observatory, located in the DMZ on the South Korean side of the 38th Parallel, you'll be able to see the spectacular Geumgangsan Diamond Mountains as well as North Korean military personnel. Back in Seoul, the balance of your evening is at leisure. MEALS B

DAY 4 | By Rail to Busan
