

First introduced in Norway by the pioneering Ulstein Group, X-bow ships like the *Ocean Victory* have a unique backward sloping bow that minimizes fuel consumption while also maximizing the vessel's stability in high seas.

Offering unmatched comfort and safety in Polar waters, the intimate *Ocean Victory* is enhanced by first-in-class luxury amenities including 93 ocean-view cabins (90% with a balcony), fine dining in two distinctive venues with free-flowing wine and beer for A+R guests, and a complete spa and wellness center.

Inviting public spaces include the Observation Lounge, Pool Deck, Library, and Bar Lounge. A state-of-the-art lecture lounge is the perfect place to enrich your voyage with engaging discussions from our shipboard team – experts in the geology, climate, history and wildlife of Antarctica. 

Our projected route will take us through the Gerlache Strait with its towering ice cliffs and pods of magnificent humpback whales.

As weather, sea and ice conditions permit, you can anticipate multiple Zodiac excursions to experience Antarctica's wonders up-close and shore landings that promise engaging wildlife encounters with our expert naturalists. Back onboard, you'll enjoy fine dining with wine and our ongoing enrichment program ranging from exploration history to Polar geology, climate and wildlife. MEALS 2B+2L+2D

DAY 11 | Total Solar Eclipse

Today's total solar eclipse will run over the South Atlantic, starting early in the morning east of the Falklands. From here, the moon shadow will speed toward South Orkney Island and Antarctica. We've selected the best possible viewing position just east of South Orkney where the sun will be 11 degrees above the horizon. Lasting for nearly 2 full minutes, this wondrous phenomenon promises a truly once-in-alifetime thrill. MEALS B+L+D

DAYS 5 TO 7 | Antarctic Sound + Weddell Sea

Rounding the tip of the Antarctic Peninsula brings us into remote waters where huge tabular icebergs roam, having broken off the floating Larsen Ice Shelf farther south. As sea and land conditions allow, we expect to make landings on both the Continent and some of the islands that dot the Antarctic Sound and Weddell Sea. Always, our sharpeyed naturalists and crew will be on-hand to point out the remarkable wildlife including large penguin colonies and all-white Snow Petrels and Pintado Petrels swooping over the ice floes. MEALS 3B+3L+3D

DAYS 8 TO 12 | South Georgia Island

Several days at sea are enhanced by engaging lectures on the geology, wildlife and climate of Antarctica and the South Atlantic; gripping tales of Polar explorers who sailed before us are also among the topics to be covered. Indeed, our planned route follows Sir Ernest Shackleton who led his men on a desperate voyage in open lifeboats until they reached Elephant Island. We expect to pass close by Elephant Island and continue in the explorer's wake until we reach South Georgia Island just as Shackleton did more than 100 years ago.

Exploring in Zodiacs with our expert naturalists and venturing ashore at a variety of landing sites on South Georgia promise unforgettable wildlife encounters. We can expect healthy populations of penguins, sea lions, seals and a wide variety of sea birds all seeking shelter on this land oasis amid the roaring Southern Atlantic.



Calling on Grytviken would offer us the opportunity to experience the island's long-ago whaling history and to visit the grave of Sir Ernest Shackleton. Cooper Bay, at the southeast tip of South Georgia, is heralded for its wealth of wildlife including Chinstrap, Gentoo and Macaroni Penguins. There are also plenty of fur seals on the beaches and unusual volcanic rock formations tower over the small fjord of the area; conditions permitting, this a terrific place for a thrilling Zodiac cruise to watch wildlife from the waterfront. MEALS 6B+6L+6D

DAYS 13+14 | The Southern Atlantic

With two days at sea, you'll have ample opportunity to engage with your fellow adventurers and to attend talks with our shipboard experts. The Library, Wellness Center and Bar Lounge also beckon. From the Top Deck you can track the storm petrels and albatrosses that follow in the wake of our ship. MEALS 2B+2L+2D

DAYS 15+16 | The Falkland Islands

Established in the early 1840's, the small town of Stanley has grown considerably, especially over the past several decades. Going ashore on our first day here, we'll enjoy a guided stroll through town. Schedule permitting, you can also visit the Historic Dockyard Museum with its exhibits on Polar expeditions, natural history and the 1982 Falklands War.

The rest of our time in the Falklands will be devoted to some of the island's many spectacular landing sites – especially

regarded among avid birdwatchers. The Falkland Thrush, Black-chinned Siskin, Striated Caracaras and Cobb's Wren are just some of the many endemic species. In addition, Gentoo and Magellanic Penguins can be observed along with Peale's and Commerson's Dolphins that often swim close to shore to approach our Zodiacs. MEALS 2B+2L+2D

DAYS 17+18 | Back to Argentina

The last leg of our voyage finds us charting a southwesterly course toward the Beagle Channel that will bring us back to Ushuaia. Take advantage of these days at sea to relax, attend a lecture or two, and to share your perspectives and trip experiences with fellow travelers. The Observation Lounge, Library, Birdseye Viewing Platform and Bar Lounge also beckon! MEALS 2B+2L+2D

DAY 2 | Tour Tierra del Fuego + Embark the mv Ushuaia

Explore the forests, lagoons and mountains of Tierra del Fuego National Park. Traveling all the way to Lapataia Bay, you'll have a chance to observe indigenous species as you learn about the region's geology, flora and fauna. Then board the mv Ushuaia and meet your expedition team as you set sail along the Beagle Channel. MEALS B+D

DAYS 3+4 | The Drake Passage

Named for Sir Francis Drake, who explored these waters in 1578, the Drake Passage marks the Antarctic Convergence, where Polar waters sink beneath warmer currents, creating an upwelling of nutrients that sustain rich marine life. As you sail across this passage, our naturalists are on deck to identify the many seabirds following in our wake. Our open bridge policy allows you to join officers to learn about navigation and watch for Minke, orca and humpback whales. Sightings of icebergs and snowcapped peaks indicate that we have reached the South Shetland Islands. With good sea conditions, you'll go ashore on Day 4 for your first landing! MEALS 2B+2L+2D



DAYS 5 TO 8 | South Shetlands and Antarctic Peninsula

A haven for wildlife, the South Shetlands offer a chance to encounter vast penguin rookeries, numerous seabirds and pristine beaches ruled by fur and elephant seals. Sailing through the narrow passage into the flooded caldera of Deception Island is amazing. On King George, you'll be greeted by Gentoo and Chinstrap penguins, kelp gulls, blue-eyed cormorants, Antarctic terns and giant petrels. Here you can also see the scientific bases of different nations. As we near the Antarctic Peninsula, you'll have ample time to explore its pristine scenery – a mountain wilderness of ice, snow and water home to a rich variety of wildlife. Apart from penguins and seabirds, you are likely to encounter Weddell, crabeater and leopard seals. Depending upon sea and ice conditions, we'll navigate some of the most beautiful waterways of the Southern Hemisphere: the Gerlache Strait, the Neumayer Channel and the Lemaire Channel – a narrow passage between towering rock faces and spectacular glaciers. With good conditions, you'll make at least two landings per day, always joined by our expert naturalists. Possible landing sites on the Continent itself include Paradise Bay, one of the most aptly named places on earth. After negotiating the iceberg-strewn waters of the Antarctic Sound, we may visit Paulet Island, home to a bustling Adélie penguin colony of 100,000 pairs. The Nordenskjöld expedition built a stone survival hut here in 1903; today its ruins have been taken over by nesting penguins. Further exploration may take you to Melchior Island, Cuverville

Island, Portal Point, Neko Harbour and Pléneau Island. If conditions permit, we'll go to Petermann Island for a visit to the southern-most colony of Gentoo penguins. MEALS 4B+4L+4D


