DAY 1 | Welcome to Zagreb

DAY 3 | Zagreb as you wish



DAY 4 | Onward to Opatija

Travel to the northern shores of the Adriatic where the Istrian Peninsula sits nestled against the Slovenian border. Check in to the *Hotel Navis* in Opatija and then join your guide for a stroll through this lovely seaside town, filled with fine gardens and landmarks from the Baroque, Rococo and Art Nouveau periods. DAY 5 | A free day in Istria

DAY 6 | Discover Zadar + Travel to Hvar

Travel to Zadar for a guided walking tour including the remains of the 2,000-year-old Roman Forum and 9th-century St. Donatus Church. Ride the catamaran ferry from Split to the island of Hvar and check in to your sea-view room at the *Hotel Adriana*. MEALS B

DAY 7 | A day in Hvar

Enjoy a walking tour through this historic town, an important harbor for Venice's mighty Adriatic fleet from the 12th through 18th centuries. See Hvar Square and the 400-year-old Cathedral of St. Stephen. Then drive up into the hills above Hvar to visit the Fortica Fortress. Dating back to the 16th century when Hvar was ruled by the Venetians, its commanding location offers breathtaking views of the port, the Adriatic Sea and Pakleni Islands.

DAY 8 | Tailor your stay on Hvar

In addition to its many historic sites, Hvar is filled with cobblestone streets that lead to tempting cafes, boutiques and waterfront vistas that are a delight to explore on your own. Or visit us online to see our available tours including a speedboat adventure to the Blue Cave or a sailing excursion to the Pakleni Islands.

DAY 9 | Discover Trogir + Split

Returning to the mainland, your private tour in Split begins inside the remarkably preserved cellars of Emperor Diocletian's magnificent 4th-century palace and continues to the Cathedral of St. Domnius, an octagonal landmark that was originally built as Diocletian's mausoleum. Farther up the Split Riviera, your privately guided tour in Trogir reveals a fine architectural ensemble including St. Lawrence Cathedral, an historic landmark that dates back nearly 1,000 years. After sightseeing, return to Split and settle in the *Hotel Luxe*. MEALS B

DAY 10 | Personalize your time in Split

With its inviting waterfront promenade and charming piazzas filled with restaurants and cafes, Split is a delight to explore at your leisure. If you prefer additional guided sightseeing, we offer a variety of activities including a full-day tour to Mostar in Bosnia and Herzegovina, a vineyard tour, and even a market visit and cooking class.
