DAY 1 | **Welcome to Zambia**

DAY 2 | **The Thrill of Victoria Falls**

Join our guide for all the best view points at Victoria Falls. After lunch, tailor your time with another included excursion: rhino tracking, fishing, a game drive, visiting the town of Livingstone, or a nearby village. MEALS B+L+D

DAY 3 | **Fly into Linyanti Reserve**

Journey into Botswana and continue by a thrilling safari flight into the remote Linyanti Reserve and *Savuti Camp*, our luxury safari bush camp. MEALS B+D

The 114 curves of Chapman's Peak is one of the world's most spectacular coastal drives, taking you to the Cape of Good Hope and all the way to the Cape Point Lighthouse.
