Enhance Your Stay in Zagreb with Additional Privately Guided Sightseeing

Private Full-Day Tour to Plitvice Lakes •: This unforgettable day takes you to one of Croatia's most amazing natural wonders. Over thousands of years, flowing waters over limestone and chalk have left behind travertine barriers. These natural dams have, in turn, created a remarkable series of 16 terraced lakes that tumble down the hillside. Ranging in hue from azure and emerald to steely grey, they're connected by rushing cascades that continue the geological processes that originally created them. Today, well maintained trails and unobtrusive wooden walkways allow you to behold and experience the majestic beauty of these pristine lakes and their beautiful forest setting. Accompanied throughout by your personal guide, you'll also enjoy a short cruise across the largest of Plitvice's lakes. Before returning to Zagreb, there will be time for you to have lunch on your own in one of the area's fine local restaurants. *This 8-hour tour includes roundtrip chauffeured transportation from Zagreb and park entry fee. It can be modified to suit your physical activity level, but the recommended route covers about 1.2 miles over gravel and flat terrain, plus approximately 300 steps.*

Private Half-Day Tour to Zagorje – Kumrovec + Veliki Tabor: With your chauffeured vehicle and personal guide, this excursion takes you into the forested hills north of Zagreb to explore important chapters of Croatia's history and culture. You'll see the house where Tito was born and the picturesque countryside where he spent his childhood. Then visit a unique open-air museum in the timeless village of Kumrovec for a fascinating look into traditional local life before the 20th century. At Veliki Tabor Castle, your privately guided tour will bring this well preserved, 15th-century fortress to life, including a colorful legend about the forbidden love between a young nobleman and a local woman. *This 5.5-hour excursion includes roundtrip chauffeured transportation from Zagreb and all entry fees*.

Private Full-Day Tour to Trakoscan Castle with Wine Tasting: Tracing its colorful history to the 13th century, Trakoscan Castle is the epitome of a fairytale palace, set on a wooded knoll overlooking park-like grounds and a tranquil lake. With insightful information from your expert guide, your private tour of Trakoscan will also include its impressive interiors – with fine Baroque furnishings, displays of weapons and important works of art. From the castle, we'll take you to a nearby family farm where you'll learn about their daily life and sample some of their fine, awardwinning wines accompanied by traditional foods produced in the region. *This 6-hour excursion includes roundtrip chauffeured transportation from Zagreb and all entry fees. The tour of Trakoscan Castle includes some uphill walking and stairs.*

Private Tour of 3 Unique Museums in Zagreb: Enhance your stay in the capital by exploring three of its unique contemporary museums—enriched by the keen cultural insights and sharp historical perspectives of your engaging guide. Begin at the Museum of Broken Relationships where an ever-growing collection of items bear witness to the loss and heartbreak of a past relationship. Each memento is accompanied by a very personal, but anonymous, story about its contributor. At the Museum of Illusions, you'll marvel at one of the world's largest collections of holograms. This tour ends at the Museum of Hangovers where you'll experience funny and interactive hangover stories. *This 3-hour excursion includes chauffeured transportation and all entry fees.*

Ljubljana, Slovenia & Lake Bled: Take a ride across the Slovenian border to visit Ljubljana , a lively city known for its small-city charm. The city center is pedestrian-only, leaving the leafy banks of the emerald-green Ljubljanica River, which flows through the city's heart, free for pedestrians and cyclists. During your tour with a local guide, you will ride the funicular to visit Ljubljana Castle and learn its storied history. After Ljubljana, your next stop is Lake Bled, well-known for its extraordinary beauty as well as the Bled Castle, a silent witness to the former power, that stands firmly and confidently on the cliff overlooking the lake. Take some time to explore both Ljubljana and Bled on own before heading back to Zagreb. *This 10-hour day trip includes roundtrip chauffeured transportation from Dubrovnik, a private local guide in Ljubljana, and all sightseeing entry fees.*
