DAY 1 | Welcome to Winnipeg

On arrival, you'll be chauffeured to the *Inn at The Forks*. This afternoon's city tour includes The Forks where you'll learn about the city's history – from ancient settlements to the arrival of European fur traders. Gather tonight for a welcome dinner. MEALS D

DAY 2 | Fly to Churchill

Transfer to the airport for our flight to Churchill where you'll be escorted to the *Lazy Bear Lodge*. Then join fellow guests to see the famed Polar Bear Jail where rogue bears are housed until

they're safely released deeper in the wilderness. At Cape Merry, you'll learn about the town's founding in 1717.

Later, A+R guests will join a local wildlife photographer for a private talk filled with helpful tips and advice for capturing terrific photos in the days ahead. During your stay, the lodge will invite you to exciting late night ventures to observe the dancing Northern Lights. Meals B+D

DAY 3 | Polar bear capital of the world

The western coast of Hudson Bay is one of the best places in the world to encounter polar bears in their native habitat. This morning, step aboard our Coast Guard certified vessel to go



in search of these amazing creatures. In late summer, the polar bears are a bit lazy, gathering on the shore and giving us an amazing opportunity to watch as they lumber among the rocks and wildflowers.

Tonight, we've made special arrangements for our guests to spend some time with a local dog musher. Hear colorful stories about life in the far north, gain insight into Manitoba's First Nations heritage and learn about the continued importance of the dog mushing culture. MEALS B+L

DAY 4 | Beluga whale watching

Set out in our maneuverable Zodiacs, to explore the Churchill River and Hudson Bay, where up to 60,000 beluga whales come every summer to feed, mate, and raise their young. Belugas are curious, and they will often swim close – as if to investigate our

boats and their 2-legged passengers! You'll also step ashore for a tour of the Prince of Wales Fort, built by the Hudson Bay Company in the 1700's.

After our Zodiac expedition, A+R guests enjoy their choice of a second included marine adventure — either by kayak or on our unique AquaGliders. Later today, join other guests for a Dog Carting adventure. Riding behind a team of energetic sled dogs is a terrific way to appreciate the beauty of the countryside. MEALS B+L

DAY 5 | Across the tundra

Hop aboard our Arctic Crawlers™ for a morning tour across the tundra – home to migratory birds, Arctic hare, Arctic fox, caribou, moose and eagles. With our expert naturalists, you and other lodge guests will get to know the geology, flora and fauna of the wildly beautiful tundra. Dine tonight at the Lazy Bear Café. MEALS B+D

DAY 6 | Return flight to Winnipeg

After a free morning, our flight brings you back to Winnipeg, where you will be escorted to the *Inn at The Forks*. MEALS B
