

Enhance Your Stay in Como with Additional Privately Guided Sightseeing

Private Half-Day Lake Como e-Bike Tour: There is no better way to discover the beauty of the Lake Como shoreline than by e-bike, traveling along scenic lakeside roads at a relaxed pace with an experienced guide. This delightful half-day excursion takes you through some of the most celebrated landscapes in all of Italy, passing through charming villages like Cernobbio, Moltrasio, and Laglio, each with its own distinct character. Along the way, you'll see waterfalls and encounter breathtaking lake views framed by Alpine peaks. A brief detour across the Swiss border offers a glimpse of vineyards in the Ticino region, known as the Swiss capital of Merlot. Covering approximately 16 miles with around 1,300 feet of elevation gain, the route follows paved roads with rolling hills and is suitable for anyone comfortable riding at a moderate pace. Before you head back, your guide will be happy to suggest a nearby restaurant for a well-earned lunch. *Tour Duration: 3 Hours*

Private Wine Tasting at Vineria Vitani: Tucked along a cobblestoned street in the heart of Como's medieval center, Vineria Vitani is a wine lover's sanctuary. Its ancient stone walls house one of the most impressive private cellars in all of Italy, with over 11,000 bottles curated with passion and expertise. In this intimate and convivial setting, you'll enjoy a guided tasting dedicated entirely to Lombardy's two most celebrated wine regions: Franciacorta, where acclaimed sparkling wines are produced with traditional French Champagne methods, and Valtellina, whose steep Alpine terraces produce elegant reds from the Nebbiolo grape. Three carefully selected wines, paired with savory appetizers, offer a rewarding introduction to the breadth and quality of Lombardy's winemaking heritage. *Tour Duration: 1.5 Hours*

Private Morning Cooking Class in Cernobbio: A short drive from Como brings you to the hilltop village of Cernobbio and the welcoming home of Debora, your host and guide for the morning. Set in a beautifully restored former barn with sweeping views of the lake, Debora's home sets the scene perfectly for an authentic and thoroughly enjoyable Italian culinary experience. As in any Italian home, you'll be welcomed with a steaming cup of coffee. Then head out to the kitchen garden to gather fresh herbs and seasonal vegetables, aperitif in hand. Back in the kitchen, Debora will teach you to make fresh pasta from scratch using organic ingredients and time-honored family recipes, followed by a classic Italian dessert. When the cooking is done, sit down together to enjoy the fruits of your efforts over a leisurely three-course lunch, with the shimmering waters of Lake Como spread out before you. *Tour Duration: 5 Hours including roundtrip transfers from Como*
