

Enhance Your Stay in Split with Additional Privately Guided Activities

Half-Day Culinary Experience – Market Visit + Cooking Class: Meet our engaging resident chef for a guided exploration of Split's colorful market. Learn about the wide variety of local produce and fresh seafood being offered by the friendly vendors and help to select some of the ingredients for your upcoming class. Back at our state-of-the-art kitchen, you'll learn to prepare a variety of traditional Croatian specialties showcasing the fresh produce and seafood procured at this morning's market visit. Then sit down to a congenial lunch featuring the dishes you've prepared – capped off with a delicious Dalmatian dessert. *This 5-hour activity includes a private return transfer from the cooking school to your hotel. Some of the dishes can be modified to your personal preferences. Gluten free options are always available.*

Half-Day Rafting at Cetina River: Discover the beauty of the Cetina River Canyon on an exciting half-day rafting adventure. Paddle through crystal-clear emerald waters, combining peaceful stretches with fun Grade II and III rapids, all surrounded by spectacular karst scenery. Suitable for beginners and adventure enthusiasts alike, this experience offers the perfect blend of nature, relaxation and excitement. Shared activity with private transfers.

Half-Day Salona & Klis Fortress Visit: Step back in time on a guided journey through the ancient history of Dalmatia with a visit to Salona, the former capital of the Roman province of Dalmatia. Explore the impressive archaeological remains of amphitheatres, basilicas and ancient city walls while discovering the fascinating story of one of the region's most important Roman settlements. Continue to the spectacular Klis Fortress, dramatically perched on a hill overlooking Split and the Adriatic coast. Once a key defensive stronghold, the fortress offers breathtaking panoramic views and a rich history spanning centuries. Recognised by many as one of the filming locations for Game of Thrones, Klis combines remarkable heritage with unforgettable scenery, making it one of the highlights of the Dalmatian hinterland.

Full-Day Excursion to Discover Brač Island: Escape to Brač Island, where spectacular scenery, authentic villages and rich island traditions combine to create an unforgettable Adriatic experience. After a scenic ferry crossing from Split, travel through Brač's picturesque interior, passing olive groves, vineyards and centuries-old stone villages. Visit the charming village of Škrip, the oldest settlement on the island, where traditional Dalmatian architecture and island life have remained largely unchanged. Continue to a local family estate or winery to learn about Brač's renowned olive oil and wine production, accompanied by a tasting of regional specialties. Then, continue on to Vidova Gora, the highest peak of all Adriatic islands, offering breathtaking panoramic views over Brač, Hvar and the famous Zlatni Rat beach. You will enjoy a short, easy walk to the viewpoints before descending to Bol, Brač's best-known seaside town. Stroll along Bol's charming seaside promenade, enjoy lunch at a local restaurant or relax with a coffee while taking in

the crystal-clear Adriatic and the island's laid-back Mediterranean atmosphere. Return to Split by ferry (or catamaran).

Private Full-Day Excursion to Sibenik + Krka National Park: Sit back and enjoy the scenery on your privately chauffeured drive to Sibenik, an enchanting coastal town graced with impressive architectural landmarks built of stone. With fascinating insight and relevant historical facts from your personal guide, you'll marvel at the spectacular Fortress of St. Nicholas, built by the Venetians in the 16th century. In Old Town, your narrated walking tour includes St. James Cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage Site that bears witness to the influences of medieval Italian architecture and art on this side of the Adriatic. Then continue to Krka National Park, famous for its lush indigenous vegetation and the magnificent cascades of the Krka River. Your visit to the National Park will include both a guided tour and free time to enjoy its natural wonders at your own pace. This 7.5-hour tour includes roundtrip chauffeured transportation from Split, privately guided sightseeing and entry fees for Krka National Park.

Wine Tasting at Bedalov Winery: The short 10-mile stretch of Dalmatian Coast west of Split is known as the Riviera of Seven Castles – a romantic moniker that bears witness to the castles that were built in the 15th and 16th centuries to defend the coast. There were once more than a dozen, but today only seven remain. Sit back and listen to fascinating stories about the region's history as you make the scenic drive with your chauffeured vehicle and guide. Upon arriving at the family-owned Bedalov Winery, you'll learn about the history of the local wine, a predecessor of the Zinfandel wines now produced in California. Delight in the pastoral beauty of this Dalmatian vineyard estate and enjoy a tasting of their fine wines – accompanied by traditional snacks. This 2-hour excursion includes roundtrip chauffeured transportation from Split, our privately guided services, and wine tasting.
