DAY 1 | **Welcome to Lima, Peru**

On arrival, you'll be escorted to the luxurious *Belmond Miraflores Park*.

DAY 2 | **Sightseeing in Lima**

Stroll the lively Barranco district before touring the Larco Museum. After lunch, discover the landmarks of Plaza Mayor in the colonial heart of Lima. Learn how to make a classic Pisco Sour before sitting down to an elegant Welcome Dinner. MEALS B+L+D

DAY 3 | **Cuzco + Sacred Valley**

Fly to Cuzco where our engaging Andean Trip Leader Carlos awaits. Descend into the Sacred Valley to see

llamas and alpacas and learn about traditional weaving techniques. Visit the Cochahuasi Animal Sanctuary and explore the colorful market in Pisac. Then check in to the enchanting *Belmond Rio Sagrado*. MEALS B+L+D

DAY 4 | **Andean history + culture**

Explore the stone fortress of Ollantaytambo and sit down to a farm-to-table lunch at Hacienda Huayocari, a lovely 17th-century estate that's been home to the Orihuela family for over 100 years. See the terraced Maras salt mines, and spend time in the workshop of a famed Andean milliner. Journey across the highlands to the Inca terraces at Moray before returning to your hotel. MEALS B+L+D

DAY 5 | **To Machu Picchu by luxury rail**

Enjoy brunch and wine aboard Belmond's stylish *Hiram Bingham Train* as you journey through the Sacred Valley's ancient farming terraces. Step off in Aguas Calientes and explore Machu Picchu as Carlos expertly sheds light on the ancient Inca and their once-mighty empire. Spend the night at the one-and-only **Belmond Sanctuary Lodge** adjacent to the Lost City. MEALS B+L+D

DAY 6 | **Machu Picchu + on to Cuzco**

Arising early at the only lodge next to Machu Picchu, you'll be among the first to enter the Lost City for a second guided visit. Watch as the sun casts its first light upon the ancient citadel. The return train journey includes cocktails and dinner. Arrive in Cuzco and check in to your oxygenated junior suite at the luxury **Belmond Palacio Nazarenas**. MEALS B+L+D

DAY 7 | **Cuzco's Inca sites**

Explore Tambomachay, a remote Inca site

with stone terraces. Then witness a purification ritual at the Temple of the Moon and see Sacsayhuaman with its views over Cuzco. Enjoy lunch at one of our local favorites followed by a free afternoon. MEALS B+L

DAY 8 | **Culture + cuisine**

Experience daily life at the lively San Pedro Market. Then tour the Cathedral and the Temple of the Sun. At a stylish kitchen overlooking Cuzco, join our chef for a hands-on cooking class. Tonight, dine at **MAP Café**, one of Cuzco's finest. MEALS B+L+D

DAY 9 | **To Lake Titicaca**

Fly to Puno and visit the remarkable pre-Inca burial towers of Sillustani. Then check in to the **GHL Lake Titicaca**, where A+R guests enjoy lakeview rooms. MEALS B+L+D

DAY 10 | **Exploring Lake Titicaca**

It's a wonder to stand upon the remarkable floating islands, built on layers of Totora reeds, and to meet the Uros people. Step ashore on Taquile Island where residents still speak the language of the Inca and weave extraordinary textiles with traditional techniques. MEALS B+L+D
