DAY 1 | Arriving in Vancouver, Canada

You'll be transferred toto our haborview hotel, the *Fairmont Waterfront*.

DAY 2 | Enjoy Vancouver + embark

After breakfast, enjoy a free morning to explore the city. Then see Vancouver on an included tour before boarding your state-of-the-art expedition vessel, the *Ocean Victory*. This evening, enjoy an elegant dinner with free-flowing wine. MEALS B+D

DAY 3 | Sailing the Inside Passage With its shallow draft and low-impact design, our ship is purpose-built to explore waterways like the pristine Inside Passage. Whether you're in the Observation Lounge or out on our one-of-a-kind viewing platform, your discovery of these wildlife-filled fjords and lush island vistas promises intimate up-close experiences reserved only for the privileged few. And with our sharp-eyed expedition team on hand, you might very well spot whales, porpoises and sea lions. You can also enjoy talks with our guest marine biologists. MEALS B+L+D

DAY 4 | Fiordland Conservancy

Enchanting inlets, fjords, waterfalls, glaciers and coastal mountains are prime habitat for black bears, grizzlies, wolves and bald eagles. We'll look for them from our fleet of Zodiacs



helmed by our expert guides. We'll navigate to the cascades of and across rarely visited Culpepper Lagoon. Meals $B{+}L{+}D$

DAY 5 | Ketchikan

The totem poles of Ketchikan stand tall and noble to welcome visitors to this picturesque port, Alaska's southernmost city. Its waterways are alive with floatplanes, fishing boats and ferries, not surprising in the salmon capital of the world. MEALS B+L+D

DAY6 | Misty Fjords

Spend an unforgettable day by zodiac exploring this seascape of cliffs, fjords and forested bays that shelter Dall porpoises, whales, sea lions, bears and moose.

DAY7 | Wrangell

Settled thousands of years ago by the Tlingit, Wrangell traces its modern start with the arrival of Russian traders in the 1800's. Engage this colorful past at the Tribal House and Wrangell Museum. MEALS B+L+D

DAY 8 | Petersburg

In the picturesque fishing village of Petersburg, we'll anchor right next to the halibut fleet that call this protected harbor home. Large cruise ships cannot enter the shallow waters, fed by nearby LeConte Glacier. The town's strong Norwegian culture is evident in the local pastries and dances that we enjoy on our visit. MEALS B+L+D

DAY 9 | Discover the Waterfall Coast

The remote east coast of Baranof Island is inaccessible to larger ships. We'll glide through this wilderness – aptly named for its many waterfalls that plunge into the sea. As the day unfolds, enjoy views from interior or exterior vantages, or upclose by zodiac or sea kayak. MEALS B+L+D

DAY 10 | Fords Terror Wilderness

This vast wilderness area is home to two of Alaska's most majestic fjords, Endicott Arm, and Tracy Arm. We'll navigate deep into pristine waters where larger ships don't venture. With our expert naturalists, explorations by zodiac and kayak offer a chance to spot whales, bears, mountain goats, harbor seals and a remarkable variety of birds. MEALS B+L+D

DAY11 | Kake on Kupreanof Island

Go ashore this morning in the remote village of Kake to experience the ancient traditions of its Tlingit residents. Later, join our naturalists to explore Frederick Sound by Zodiac. MEALS B+L+D

DAY 13 | Depart Sitka

Disembark and see the sights of Sitka on an included tour ending at the airport.. MEALS B
