DAY1 | Welcome to Lima

On arrival, you'll be escorted to the deluxe *JW Marriott Hotel*, set on a cliff with dramatic views of the Pacific Ocean.

DAY 2 | Discover Lima

From the vibrant seaside district of Miraflores to historic Plaza Mayor in the Colonial heart of Lima and the famed Larco Museum, your guided tour reveals the city's richly contrasting old and new facets. End your day in Barranco, where historic buildings are now home to thriving galleries. This evening, enjoy dinner with wine. MEALS BHD

DAY 3 | Into the Sacred Valley

Fly to Cuzco ② and join Ana Maria, our Andean-born Trip Leader. In the Sacred Valley visit Manos de la Comunidad to learn about the ancient weaving techniques still used in the high-mountain villages. Then visit Cochahuasi Animal Sanctuary and explore Pisac's market before your arrival at the *Aranwa Sacred Valley Resort*. MEALS B+L

DAY 4 | Explore the Sacred Valley

Witness a Tribute to the Earth, performed by a shaman, and tour the imposing fortress at Ollantaytambo. At a local farm, you'll learn about coffee roasting and organic farming before sitting down to an Andean Pachamanca lunch. End your day at the Seminario pottery studio. MEALS BHL

DAY 5 | By rail to Machu Picchu

A 3-day visit to the Lost City begins with a scenic rail journey through the Sacred Valley, a timeless land of Andean peaks, peaceful villages and terraced fields that have been cultivated for centuries. Arrive in Aguas Calientes and ascend to Machu Picchu for a fascinating tour as Ana Maria illuminates the history of the ancient Inca. Spend two nights at the *Inkaterra Pueblo Hotel*, nestled in a cloud forest below Machu Picchu. MEALS BHLHD

DAY 6 | Morning at Machu Picchu

Explore the Lost City again in the soft morning light before the day visitors arrive; it's an unforgettable experience. This afternoon you can discover the charming riverside town of Aguas Calientes and the lush gardens and forest around your hotel.

DAY7 | Return to Cuzco

Journey by rail and along the way visit the ancient agricultural terraces of Yucay. Continue on to Cuzco where your oxygenated room at the deluxe *Aranwa Cuzco* awaits. MEALS B+D

DAY 8 | Explore Cuzco with Ana Maria

Join Ana Maria and discover iconic landmarks like Sacsayhuaman and the Temple of the Sun. Mingle with residents at the San Pedro Market for insight into local flavors and daily life. MEALS B

DAY 9 | Venture off-the-beaten-path to Oropesa + Cuyuni

Rarely visited by other travelers, Oropesa is a handsome Colonial town celebrated for its generations-old bread-making traditions. Take in the tantalizing aroma and sample fresh Oropesa bread before continuing to the remote village of Cuyuni where you'll mingle and stroll with residents. They'll take you through their village and fields, sharing with you a way of life that has changed little over the centuries. Back in Cuzco, dine tonight in one of our favorite restaurants.
