

**Enhance Your Stay in Kakslauttanen  
with Additional Privately Guided Sightseeing**

**Planetarium Visit**

Take a visit to Kakslauttanen's private planetarium, which highlights captivating documentaries about the celestial wonders of the Arctic region. **Duration: 25-30 minutes**

**Visit Santa's Home (with transfers)**

Bundle up to head out to Santa's Village where you will get a chance to meet Santa himself. After getting to know Father Christmas, head to Celebration House to enjoy a warm drink. Remember to lookout for reindeer along the way! **Duration: 1.5 hours**

**Nordic Ski Lesson with instructor w/ clothing rental**

Also known as Cross Country Skiing, Nordic skiing is a national sport and pastime in Finland. Luckily for guests of Kakslauttanen, there are 200km of tracks starting just in front of the resort. Your instructor will provide you with the gear and foundations for a successful venture into the wilderness. **Duration: 1 hour**

**Husky Safari**

Set out today through the wintry forest on your dog sleigh and experience the exhilaration of Lappish adventures. Your expert guide will give you instructions on how to use the sled and you will set off altogether for a fun day in the Arctic. Please note that unless otherwise specified, you will share the sled with one person. **Duration: 2 hours**

**Reindeer Safari**

After greeting your reindeer and some instructions from your guide, you will board your sled and get comfortable under some blankets and embark into the wilderness. Enjoy the calm pace, relax into your sled, and take in the sights and sounds of Finnish Lapland. **Duration: 2 hours**

**Aurora Hunting with Reindeer**

Embark in a once-in-a-lifetime adventure as you chase the Northern Lights from the comfortability of a reindeer sled. Your expert guide will meet you, bundle you up in all the winter gear you need, and together you'll set out on the serene hunt for the aurora borealis. You'll enjoy a toasty midway break to warm up by an open fire, enjoy some warm juice, and hear stories about the reindeer of Lapland **Duration: 2 hours**

**Romantic Aurora hunting with Horse Sleigh**

Enjoy a private nighttime horse-drawn sleigh ride through the silent, Arctic night. Toast to each other with a glass of sparkling wine from the cozy sleigh, and hopefully you'll even catch a glimpse of the Northern Lights. ***Duration: 1 hour***

### **Aurora hunting with horse Sleigh**

Two noble Finnhorses will pull your shared sled through the wintry forest to hunt the aurora. Midway through your ride, you will pause to take in the lights above and to enjoy warm drinks and learn about the culture and nature of Lapland. ***Duration: 1.5 hours***

### **Horseback Riding**

After arriving to the Kakslauttanen horse stables, you'll receive your riding gear and instructions before setting out on a leisurely ride. Finnhorses, the national breed of Finland, are a calm and noble breed, making them a delight to ride on (even for those with no previous riding experience). After the ride, bid farewell to your steeds and head inside for a warm drink and a treat. ***Duration: 2 hours***

### **Snowmobile Safari**

Set out on the fastest and most adrenaline pumping way to see Lapland – on the back of your very own snowmobile. Ride into the snowy forest with your guide to enjoy some of the best scenery in the whole region. Whether you choose the 2- or 4-hour option, you will be sure to have an exhilarating time. ***Duration: 2 or 4 hours***

### **Aurora Hunting with Snowmobile**

Delight in chasing the aurora from your very own snowmobile. Embark into the magical winter landscape with a burst of adrenaline as you shoot off in search of the elusive Northern Lights. There will be a few breaks for photos and warm juice along the way. If you are uneasy about operating a snowmobile at night, there are snowmobile sleds you can book. ***Duration: 3 hours (on snowmobile at least 1.5 hours)***

### **Full Day Sampo Ice Breaker excursion**

Set off on a long, but rewarding, full day into the arctic to the Gulf of Bothnia. After serving 30 years in the demanding arctic waters, Icebreaker Sampo now welcomes guests aboard for winter adventures. One of Finland's most popular tourist attractions, you will set out on this icebreaker cruise from Kemi and even take a dip into the Bay of Bothnia (in a dry suit, of course!) if you are brave enough! ***Duration: 15 hours – transfer from Kakslauttanen to Kemi is 5 hours each way. Cruise is 4 hours.***
