Palermo Highlights

Explore the vibrant Palermo area, known for its parks, trendy cafes, and boutiques. Drive by landmarks like Floralis Generica and visit the Japanese Garden and the Rose Garden. Choose from top museums such as MALBA or the Museum of Decorative Art or the Fine Arts Museum. Enjoy free time in Palermo Soho before ending the tour at El Ateneo, one of South America's most beautiful and iconic bookstores.

Teatro Colon Opera House

Visit one of Buenos Aires' most iconic landmarks, the Teatro Colón, built in 1908 to meet the rising demand for opera. On a guided tour shared with other visitors, explore magnificent rooms like the Gold Hall and admire the intricate architecture and ornate details. The theatre, which can accommodate up to 2,500 people, has hosted world-renowned artists such as Caruso, Pavarotti, Maria Callas, and many more. You'll also see the main hall, orchestra pit, and stage where some of the greatest performances have taken place. *Tour Duration 2 Hours. Offered daily*.

Teatro Colon Opera House & Artisans tour

Visit one of Buenos Aires' most iconic landmarks, the Teatro Colón, built in 1908 to meet the rising demand for opera. On a guided tour shared with other visitors, explore magnificent rooms like the Gold Hall and admire the intricate architecture and ornate details. The theatre, which can accommodate up to 2,500 people, has hosted world-renowned artists such as Caruso, Pavarotti, Maria Callas, and many more. Afterward, visit the Fábrica in La Boca, a vibrant collective space where you can discover the great productions created by the artisans of one of the few Factory Theaters in the world: sets, costumes, wigs, shoes, special effects. This tour offers a unique insight into the artistic process in one of Buenos Aires' most colorful and culturally rich neighborhoods.

Tour Duration 4 Hours. From Friday to Sunday in the afternoon.

Classic Architectural tour

Immerse yourself in the city's architectural treasures by looking up to admire its iconic domes. Historically, domes symbolized opulence and a connection with God. The most impressive examples are found on Mayo Avenue, in the financial district, and near the courthouse area. With your local expert guide, admire grand palaces and learn about the country's history as you pass landmarks like the "Círculo Militar," San Martín Palace, and the Kavanagh Building. End your tour at iconic Barolo Palace, inaugurated in 1923 and designed by Mario Palanti, inspired by Dante's Divine Comedy. Take in panoramic views of Buenos Aires from the 22nd-floor lighthouse, overlooking Avenida de Mayo and the Congress building. Finish your experience with a visit to one of the city's historic literary cafés, for a coffee and snack at a quintessential local spot. *Tour Duration 4 Hours. Offered daily except Tuesday*.

Palermo Graffiti Tour

Discover why Buenos Aires is a street art capital as you explore the vibrant murals of Palermo. See stunning urban art created by local and international artists, reflecting the city's culture, politics, and, of course, football scenes. Finish the tour with a taste of a typical local treat, such as coffee or a delicious ice cream at a nearby café. *Tour Duration 3 Hours. Offered daily*.

Tango history & lesson tour

Discover the legacy of Carlos Gardel, one of tango's most iconic figures. Explore off-the-beaten-path neighborhoods where he began his career and visit the Carlos Gardel Museum, located in his former home, to see personal items and tango artifacts. Pay tribute at Chacarita Cemetery, Buenos Aires' largest, where Gardel is buried. End the tour with a shared 1-hour tango lesson, where your instructor will teach you the basic steps of this captivating dance at one of the city's renowned tango houses. *Tour Duration 4 Hours. Offered daily except Tuesday*.

Porteño life & football stadium tour

Immerse yourself in Argentine culture and passion for soccer on this exciting tour. Morning visit of La Boca, Buenos Aires' most colorful neighborhood, and visit the La Boca Museum and Stadium, home to one of South America's most iconic football teams. Learn about the club's history through interactive exhibitions and multimedia displays. If available, take a tour of the legendary "La Bombonera" stadium. Along the way, admire street art featuring Argentine football legends like Messi and Maradona. End the tour with a local experience at a traditional pizzeria near Corrientes Avenue and the Obelisk, enjoying a classic Argentine pizza. *Tour Duration 4 Hours. Offered daily.* <u>NOTE</u>: The football stadium visit is subject to the schedules of local football matches and music concerts.

Classic Recoleta & Evita Museum Tour

Explore the elegant Recoleta neighborhood, known for its upscale shops, cafes, and beautiful parks along Alvear Avenue. Visit the Recoleta Cultural Center, a hub for art and culture, and admire the neighborhood's French-style architecture and sculptures. On weekends, enjoy the local handicraft markets and outdoor events. Then, visit the Evita Museum to learn about Eva Perón's impactful role in Argentina's social and political history. End the tour with a local treat: coffee and alfajores, traditional Argentine sweets.

Tigre & Delta Boat tour

Leave your hotel and drive 33 km (21 mi.) north to the outskirts of Buenos Aires. Tigre is a popular weekend getaway for many locals, with summer homes and numerous yacht and rowing clubs. Enjoy a 1-hour shared boat excursion along the Paraná Delta, navigating through its channels, rivers, streams, and islands, all while admiring the lush vegetation. On Sundays, enjoy the lively atmosphere of the Mercado de Frutos, where you can find a wide variety of local products and crafts. *Tour Duration 4 Hours. Offered daily*.

Buenos Aires' Countryside: Estancia Day tour

Leave Buenos Aires and drive 110km (69mi.) to San Antonio de Areco, the heart of Argentina's "gaucho" traditions in the Pampas region. Upon arrival, walk along the cobblestone streets of this quaint village and explore its historical center, known as the 'Cradle of Tradition'. Founded over 280 years ago, the town is home to old bars ("pulperías") and artisan shops, with more than 30 silversmiths specializing in traditional Argentine silverwork, such as knives and jewelry. After exploring the village, head to the El Ombú de Areco ranch for a classic Argentine "asado" barbecue lunch, accompanied by drinks and folkloric music. Horseback riding or carriage riding activities are also included during your visit to the ranch.

Tour Duration 7-8 Hours. Offered daily.
