

Enhance Your Stay in London with Additional Privately Guided Sightseeing

Best of London Private Day Tour: Discover two sides of London on this immersive privately guided walking tour—where royal tradition meets centuries of history. Begin in Westminster, taking in Trafalgar Square, The Mall, St. James’s Palace, and Buckingham Palace—where you’ll catch the Changing of the Guard. Stroll past #10 Downing Street, Big Ben and the majestic Houses of Parliament before pausing for a traditional pub lunch, arriving in style via electric black cab. In the afternoon, explore the storied streets of the City of London. Step inside St. Paul’s Cathedral and ascend to the Whispering Gallery beneath Wren’s magnificent painted dome.

Then trace the city’s ancient roots at the Roman Amphitheatre and Guildhall and admire the evolving skyline dotted with modern architectural icons bearing affectionate names like the Gherkin and Walkie-Talkie. Visit Diagon Alley’s real-life inspiration, see the Monument marking the Great Fire’s starting point, and end at the Tower of London—home to the Crown Jewels and a thousand years of intrigue. Rubens at the Palace—Afternoon Tea with Champagne: Indulge in a quintessentially British tradition with a royal twist at *The Rubens at the Palace*, a luxurious 5-star hotel overlooking the Royal Mews of Buckingham Palace. Settle into the elegant Palace Lounge and enjoy a traditional afternoon tea featuring delicate finger sandwiches, freshly baked scones with clotted cream and preserves, and an array of exquisite pastries—all served with a glass of Champagne. As you relax in this regal setting, take in views of the royal carriages coming and going just outside, adding a touch of pageantry to this refined cultural and culinary experience. A short taxi ride brings you to Manchester Square where an elegant Georgian mansion is now home to the Wallace Collection. This lesser-known art museum features paintings by Rubens, Canaletto, and Fragonard, alongside fine furniture, porcelain, and decorative arts. Conclude your day with a traditional English afternoon tea served in the Wallace’s glass-roofed courtyard café. Tour includes admission to all galleries, roundtrip transfers and afternoon high tea at the Wallace House.

Harry Potter in London Private Tour: Perfect for fans of all ages, this privately guided walking tour brings the world of Harry Potter to life across real London streets. Led by an expert guide, you’ll uncover filming locations and literary inspirations woven into the city’s historic streets and landmarks. Rowling, the films, and the city itself. Your tour ends in Leicester Square, where a statue of Daniel
