DAY 1 | **Arrive Havana**

Hop aboard the ferry to Regla and cross the harbor for the best views of Havana's centuries-old fortresses. Then walk through Old Havana 📍 and hear about its colonial history. After lunch, spend time with artists in their studio for a "behind the scenes" peek into the art world. Drop by the recording studio made famous by the Buena Vista Social Club. Experience

Cuban music and dance with a Rumba professional, and visit Callejon de Hamel, a lively, colorful alley filled with local art and people. Dine tonight at La Guarida. MEALS B+L+D

DAY 3 | **Cigars + the Viñales Valley**

Travel into the beautiful Viñales Valley 📍 and discover the birthplace of the world's finest cigars. Learn how to hand-roll a cigar and spend time with farmers for a deeper look into their life and even their musical traditions.

DAY 4 | **From the Revolution to Hemingway**

Delve into Cuban history from the 1950's mobsters who populated the elegant Hotel Sevilla to the monuments of Revolution Square.



DAY 6 | *Onward to Trinidad*

Visit the Botanical Garden and learn from park staff about their long relationship with Harvard University. Continue to historic Trinidad to discover its fine Colonial architecture along cobble-stoned streets. Stay at the intimate **JM432**, right in the center of town.

After visiting a local school, enjoy a typically Cuban dance lesson at the local Salsa Club. Then explore the Valley de los Ingenios where centuries-old sites bear witness to the development of Cuba's sugar cane industry.

DAY 8 | *Santa Clara + Back to Havana*

Delve into many decades of Cuban history from the old Spanish settlement of Sagua La Grande to the Che Guevara Memorial. Enjoy lunch at the Café Museo Revolución and see the owner's collection of rare memorabilia from the Cuban Revolution. Return to Havana.

DAY 9 | *Bid adios to Cuba*

Transfer to the airport for your flight home.

Visit the Museum of the Revolution, set in the former Presidential Palace. Stops at markets let you compare the different ways Cubans shop and what they pay for food. Later, a vintage American car takes us to Finca Vigia where Hemingway lived and wrote. Continue to Cojimar, the village that inspired *The Old Man and the Sea*, and take in the views from El Morro fortress.

DAY 5 | *Cienfuegos*

Drive to Cienfuegos to see the town's fine ensemble of architectural gems. After lunch in a nearby fishing village, hear the Cienfuegos Choir and meet the singers. Then check in to the **Casa Buenavista** and meet local writers and artists.

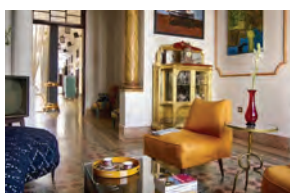


Evocative Hotels in Terrific Settings
