### DAY 1 | Welcome to Reykjavik

### DAY 2 | Old Town + Blue Lagoon

A tasting tour in Reykjavik's Old Town reveals Iceland's culinary heritage from Viking traditions to the latest trends. Then onward to the Blue Lagoon for a relaxing soak in its warm, mineral-rich waters. MEALS B+L

### DAY 3 | Akureyri + Húsavík

Fly to coastal Akureyri to explore this beguiling town. Continue to Húsavík, where our guided marine expedition offers a chance to observe minke, humpback, blue, and sperm whales, as well as dolphins and many Arctic birds. Return to Akureyri for two nights at *Hotel Kea*, our city-center hotel.

### DAY 4 | Godafoss + Lake Mývatn

Marvel at the spectacular Godafoss – “Waterfall of the Gods.” Discover lava fields and steaming fumaroles en route to the startlingly clear underground river at the Grjotagja Rift. At the Mývatn Natural Baths, unwind in steaming geothermal pools overlooking the lake. MEALS B





### DAY 5 | *Westward to the Snæfellsnes*

On today's westward journey to the Snæfellsnes Peninsula, learn about traditional Icelandic farming at Eiríksstaðir – a faithful reimagining of the Erik the Red's 10th-century farmstead. Your guide will keep watch for the many local bird species on the route to our charming hotel on the peninsula's southern coast, *Hotel Búdir*.

### DAY 6 | *Exploring the Snæfellsnes*

Spend the day exploring the Peninsula's diverse wonders, from the tiny village of Arnarstapi to Kirjufell mountain with its stunning waterfall. Enjoy lunch and a tour at a family-run horse farm, then, continue on to the charming fishing port of Stykkishólmur.

### DAY 7 | *Golden Circle Tour*

Journey southward for our Private Golden Circle Tour – from Thingvellir National Park ☉ descend into the valley, then ascend onto the Eurasian Continent to reach the tranquil



shores of Lake Thingvallavatn, where you'll see the world's oldest democratic Parliament. Then thrill to two of Iceland's most famous geological wonders – the Strokkur Geyser and the Golden Waterfall! Visit a sustainable farm before ending the day at the inviting *Hotel Rangá*. MEALS B+D

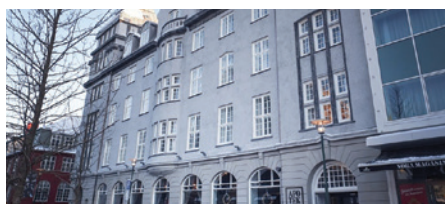
### DAY 8 | *Ice caves, beaches + waterfalls*
