#### DAY 2 | Facets of Buenos Aires

#### DAY 3 | Charming San Telmo

Discover colorful La Boca, where the Tango was born, and spend time in historic San Telmo, where a weekly antique fair draws more than 250 vendors. Join residents out to shop and enjoy the impromptu performances of tango and theater that make this such a lively event. Then visit Zanjon de Granados; dating to the 1700's, this unique subterranean architectural site encompasses tunnels and cisterns that have been reconstructed and lit. #### DAY 4 | Fly to Iguassu

Fly to Iguassu and transfer to the luxurious *Belmond Das Cataratas*, the only hotel inside Brazil's Iguassu National Park . #### DAY 5 | The Argentine side of the Falls
