Enhance Your Stay in Bali with Additional Privately Guided Sightseeing

East Bali by Vintage Car

Transfer by vintage Volkswagen car to Amlapura in the East of Bali and enjoy coffee and refreshments at a charming restaurant with scenic views over rice paddies and the majestic Mt. Agung before you get an exclusive behind the scenes tour of the “Puri Agung”, the Palace of Amlapura, once the residence of the royal family of Karangasem. Continue to Lontar Museum, showcasing palm-leaf manuscripts inscribed in Sanskrit before moving on to the local incensory run by women of East Bali. Then head onwards to reach the Tirta Gangga Water Palace, built in 1946 during the reign of the late raja of Karangasem and conclude your tour at Taman Ujung Water Palace, the sister site of Tirta Gangga built by the same Raja. *Daily 8:00 - 16:00*

Bali Street Food Experience

Meet your local food specialist at a traditional Balinese house and see how coconut oil is produced and used to make ‘Pepes Clengis’, a traditional steamed grated coconut dish with Balinese spices wrapped in Banana leaves. Stop at a small local Warung for a popular refreshment called ‘Cendol’, before you take a walk around the famous Gianyar Night Market, known for having some of the best food in Bali. Try a Balinese specialty named ‘Bubur Injin’, a fermented black sticky rice cake. End the evening at a local bamboo restaurant to experience a traditional ‘Megibung’ dining experience, in which people share several typical meals served on a banana leaf. *Daily 14:00 to 20:00*

Sanur Village E-Bike

In the morning transfer to the starting point and begin your cycling tour along the beach to the very south of Sanur. You will reach the mangrove forest and take a short walk along the nature trail. Back on your e-bike, you will cross the busy Bypass to get to the quiet backstreets and rice paddies of Sanur. Along the way you will pass traditional Balinese houses and temples, and your guide will be happy to provide you with insights into the culture, customs and beliefs of the local people. Following a stop at the local market, you will cross the Bypass again and continue cycling along the beachside until you reach the Sanur Turtle Conservation Centre. Indulge in a refreshing young coconut at a local warung, then proceed cycling through small backroads of Sanur village before you return the electric bike at the starting point. *Daily 8:00 - 12:00*

South Bali Coast Surfing Lesson

This private surf lesson offers a personalized and focused approach. Over the course of 1.5 hours, you will have the chance to acquire and refine your surfing skills in the beautiful surf areas surrounding Sanur or Legian. Your experienced instructor will impart surfing wisdom, covering topics such as proper positioning, paddling techniques, and effective wave-catching and riding. Get ready to ride the waves and dive into the thrilling world of surfing!

Daily 7:00 - 10:00

West Nusas Penida Adventure

Visit Bali's raw and unspoiled sister island. In the morning you will embark on a fast boat and cross within 45 minutes (shared cruise) to the neighboring island of Nusa Penida. Experience a visit to the magnificent Paluang and Kelingking Cliffs. Drive to the famous Angel's Billabong, the nearby Broken Beach (Pasih Uug) and conclude with a swim at Crystal Bay. *Daily 7:00 to 17:00*

Sunset Over Uluwatu + Kecak Dance

Visit the famous Uluwatu Temple. Perched approx. 70 meters above sea level, the temple has one of the most dramatic locations on the island and is the perfect vantage point to observe the huge waves crashing against the rock face below. Next, witness a traditional display of Kecak dance, which features up to a hundred male performers who form a circle and sway and chant to hypnotic music. Jimbaran Bay has a reputation for having some of the best seafood on the island and you will have the chance to dine in one of Jimbaran's best beach restaurants.

Daily 14:30 - 20:30

Antiquity of the East Coast

Visit Klungkung Palace. The Kertagosa Pavilion is one of the best-preserved parts of the palace and an excellent example of traditional Balinese architecture. Travel into the countryside through the beautiful rice paddy fields of Rendang, passing local villages en route. Arrive at Candidasa beach, with time to shop, enjoy a cool drink and lunch before visiting the village of Tenganan, home of the Bali Aga, considered to be the original inhabitants of Bali. The final stop is the Balinese Hindu temple at Goa Lawah, known locally as the 'Bat Cave' after the hordes of bats that inhabit it. *Daily 8:00 - 17:00*
